Predefined Process & Organization

- A structured process predefined and safe!
 - 8 step model based on SmartEnCity IEP-process
- Segmentation into 8 working groups
- Timeline: April => December 2018

 Same stakeholders are now busy supporting the execution of the Roadmap and <u>their</u> 52 projects















- CIOP: City Information Open Platform
 - Today 700 sensors collect data around the entire Sonderborg-area
 - Municipal buildings, house associations, ...
 - Geo data/information regarding locations for EVchargers, public toilets, windturbines, SWIP-box locations, ...
 - DIY climate-tools for citizens
- The ambition is in 2021 to boost data-collection by factor 10 based on company and citizen participation
 - Attractive services & APPs
 - Co-financed by the EU SmartEnCity
 - Local innovative SME's as partners



 - Secure the Roadmap2025-execution by cooperation, (digital) competencies and support
- Integrate green job creations
 - 100+ new green knowledge jobs before the end of 2022



- creating a new national DK CAP-platform






- Based on C40 Climate Action Planning Framework
 - Climate mitigation (buildings, energy, transport),
 adaptation and farming
 - Define binding targets, political commitment,
 PPP-cooperation, integrated inclusive planning
- 20 danish municipalities in process, remaining will follow
 - Sonderborg, Samsø & Roskilde completed
 - Another 40 + 20 will follow 2021 + 2022
 - Will improve local/regional climate action competences and commitment
- Supported by Realdania, Danske Regioner, KL
- After planning: next stop is how to ramp up and scale actions!











Cities across the world are **taking actions to combat climate change**. Driven by responsibility, citizen pressure and new green job-creation.

New common city-platforms are being developed and will help cities speed up their actions and provide a local platform for coordinated climate planning and actions engaging citizens, companies and stakeholders.
